

Principles of Clinical Pharmacology - Overview

National Institutes of Health (NIH), United States of America has selected **JSS University, Mysore** as a remote site to offer a certificate course in ‘**Principles of Clinical Pharmacology**’ for the academic year 2011-12. The course will be conducted at **JSS College of Pharmacy, Mysore**, a constituent college of JSS University. The course on ‘Principles of Clinical Pharmacology’ was designed and offered to meet the needs of healthcare professionals and scientific researchers with an interest in the clinical pharmacologic aspects of contemporary drug development and utilization.

The course consists of FIVE modules with a weekly lecture series covering the fundamentals of clinical pharmacology as a translational scientific discipline focused on rational drug development and utilization in therapeutics.
